

## **WHAT IS TEEN TALK?**

Teen Talk Youth in Alternative Settings (YAS) is an adaptation of Teen Talk, a curriculum created by Health Connected and used in many CA schools.

- A state-compliant sex ed curriculum
- Reviewed by former foster youth and adapted for youth in foster care
- Complies with laws related to the rights of youth in foster care
- Vetted for medical and legal accuracy

## **ELIGIBILITY**

- Youth in foster care, with open cases with DCFS or suitably placed through probation
- Youth ages 12-17, or enrolled in high school
- Headphones & personal devices that connects to Zoom

## **SB 89 & CHILD WELFARE**

- Requires to verify youth has received compliant sex ed
- If youth haven't received it, requires to ensure youth receive sex ed
- Youth must receive sex ed once in middle school and once in high school
- (CA Ed Code Sections 51930-51939)
