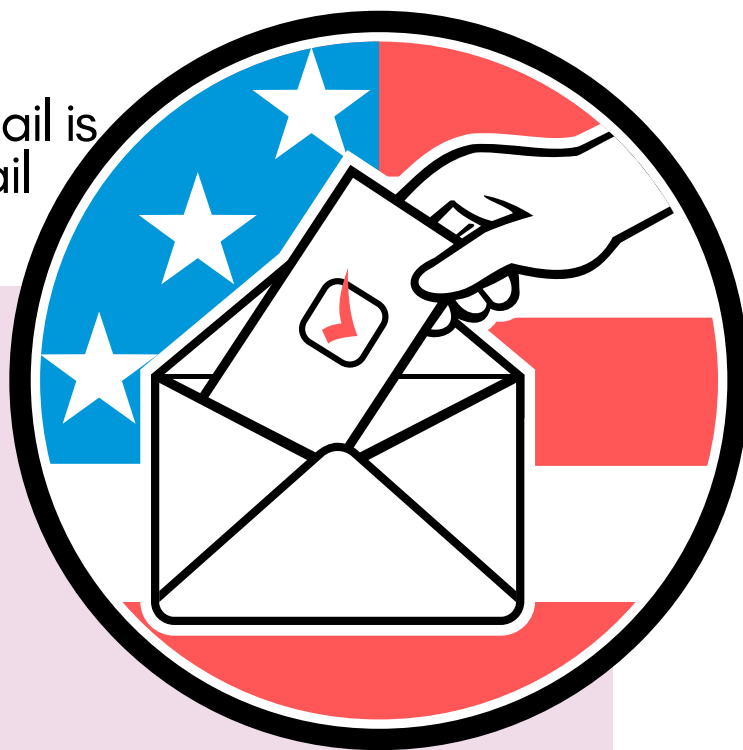


PROS & CONS OF VOTING BY MAIL

A BALLOT WILL BE SENT TO YOU IF YOU ARE REGISTERED TO VOTE.

The deadline to register to vote by mail is Oct 21, 2024. Register to vote by mail online at: [registertovote.ca.gov](https://register tovote.ca.gov)



LESS PRESSURE: Voting by mail can give you more time to think about what you would like to vote for, write notes, and have discussions with the ballot nearby. Since your ballot is mailed directly to your home, so you have a longer timeframe to vote.

ACCESSIBILITY: More people are able to vote when they can do it on their own time from the comfort of their home. You can drop off your ballot at a nearby mailbox and don't need a stamp!

ADDRESS: Those without a permanent, reliable address may find it more difficult to vote by mail.

DELAYS: Time delays concerning whether or not your ballot was received and accepted.

CONFUSION: Easy to get confused by deadlines, how to fill in the ballot, and how to mail the ballot.
